>> Call for papers and posters proposals

Papers and articles presented must be original, related to relevant issues concerning research and applied to organic farming and Agroecology, not published before or under review for any journal or magazine. All papers will be reviewed according to criteria of originality, clarity and contribution to the thematic. All approved papers will be included in the Congress proceedings which will be published in CD format. The best works will be published in the SEAE regular scientific Journal "Agroecology". The Award "Álvaro Altés" will be given to the best poster.

>> Panel Papers

Proposals of Panel Papers are expected (a minimum of 3 to 5) with similar thematic but tackling different aspects of the topic. Each author will make a short presentation of 15 minutes, mainly focussed on the conclusions of the study. When all presentations are finalised the debate will be open to the floor.

The proposals for panels, should include the title, the summary of each paper, as well as the name of the proposed moderator. This proposals has to be sent to the

Each paper proposal must contain an abstract of 200 words, in 12 Times New Roman), indicating title (in capitals), name and institution of author, address and e-mail, and 3-7 keywords (not included in the title). SEAE will provide guide Norms for the presentation.

>> Individual papers

Individual papers can be oral or poster format. The oral papers will be grouped in panels of similar thematic, being developed in a similar way as the previous poster panels.

Proposals for scientific poster and those that the scientific Committee considers can be also exhibited at spaces such entitled to it during sessions of the Congress.

The authors will have 5 minutes to present their findings in a special poster session of the Congress.

The Spanish Society of Organic Agriculture (SEAE), is organising a scientific and technical congress since 1994, every two years in order to exchange research results and research advances in organic production, and to analyse its contribution to the development of organic sector, conforming a forum to dialogue and debate with the stakeholders, generating ideas and new future projects. The last 8 years, this exchange was extended to the Latin-American areas. This 9th Congress of SEAE highlights the contribution of OA to the Mediterranean food quality and security, from which we still have little research, in order to stimulate studies in this field.

Catalunya is the region where more organic food is consumed in Spain. For that reason and the fact that an Action Plan for organic food and farming is being implemented from 2008-2012, by different departments, coordinated by the Department of Agriculture and Rural Action (DAR), we found this region a better option compared to other for the IX Congress of SEAE. The choice of Lleida city with a large agricultural tradition has been motivated by various facts, such the interest of the High level Technical School of Agriculture Engineers (ETSEA) from the University of Lleida, in introducing the agro-ecological approach as a Degree in agronomy, initiated by a group teachers, coupled with the support of the Local and Province Authorities which have supported and promoted different organic farmers street fairs together with the commitment of SEAE to face challenges of the the agricultural sector in its development, maintaining a rotational venue for the SEAE Congress, Lleida was an ideal location for it.

- To discuss / to present the implications of recent findings of research in organic farming
- To debate about the methods of transfer and adaptation of technological innovations in organic operators, organic stakeholders and other representatives of groups that support OA
